- **2018 Award for Innovations in Urban Forestry in Wisconsin Award: Kenosha County Parks awarded for the Mechanized Tree Removal and Utilization Project (EAB removal project).**

 - Kemper Maintenance: 14 roofs
 - Parks: Pets #4, Silver Lake Pump House, Silver Lake Shelter "C"
 - Construction documents completed
 - Set to bid in early March
 - **Pike River Restoration – Phase I** (see attached overview)
 - Permits submitted
 - Final construction documents and technical specifications completed
 - Bids out in March
 - Project to start June, 2018
 - **KD Park Trails – Phase I**
 - Bid Awarded to Janke General Contractors, Inc.
 - **Pre-Con meeting mid-March**
 - Project to be completed by 7/1/18
 - **Fox River Playground** (see attached plan)
 - Construction to start early April
 - Project to be completed by 6/1/18
 - **Kemper Sidewalk Replacement**
 - Replacing approximately 60 sidewalk slabs in 2018
 - **Silver Lake Park – Solar Panel & Credit Card Payments**
 - Installing solar panels at fee booth entrance to connect Wi-Fi and accept credit cards for entrance fees and watercraft rentals
- **Narcan Training:** Kenosha County Park staff was trained to administer Narcan nasal spray to known or suspected opioid overdoses.



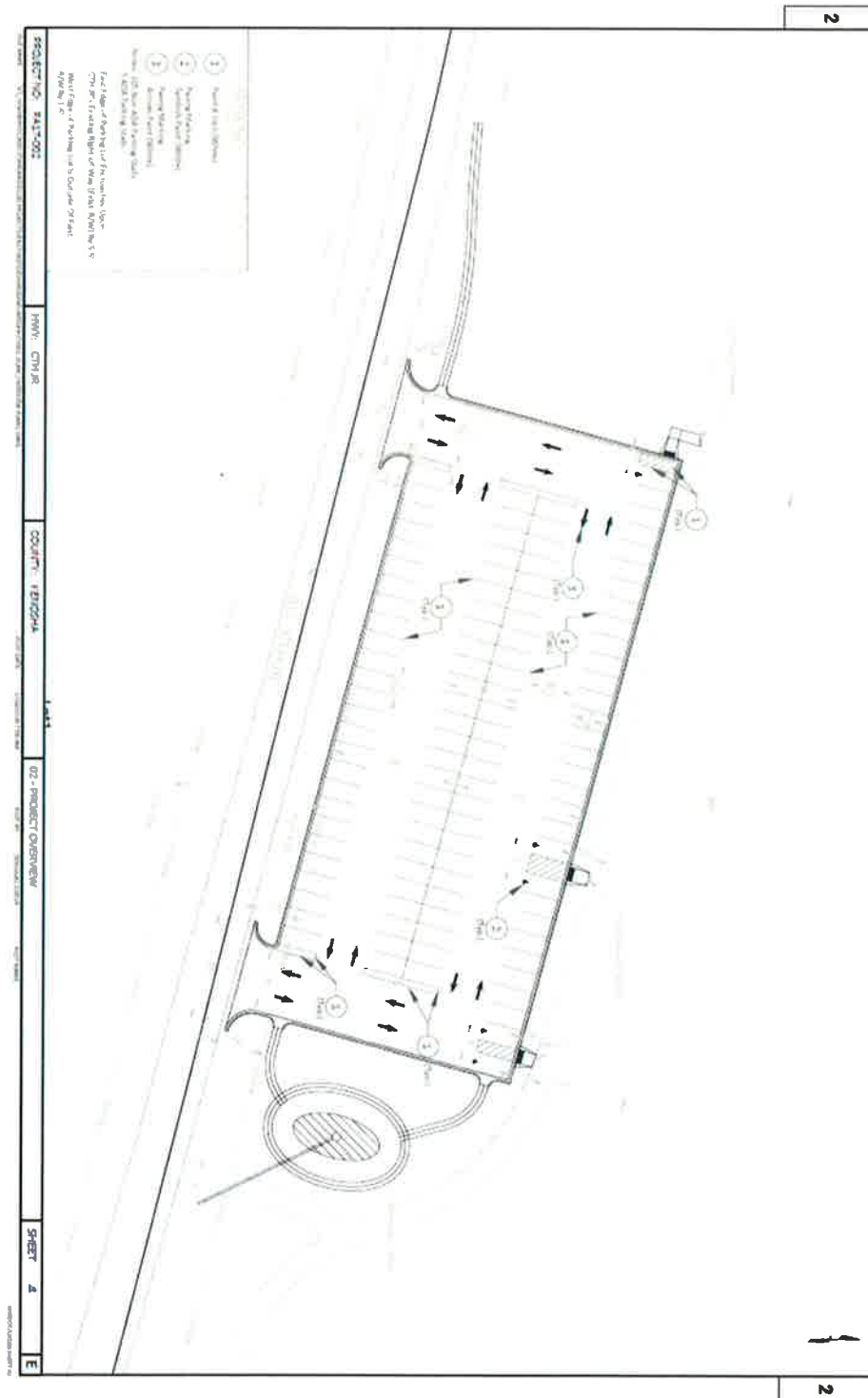

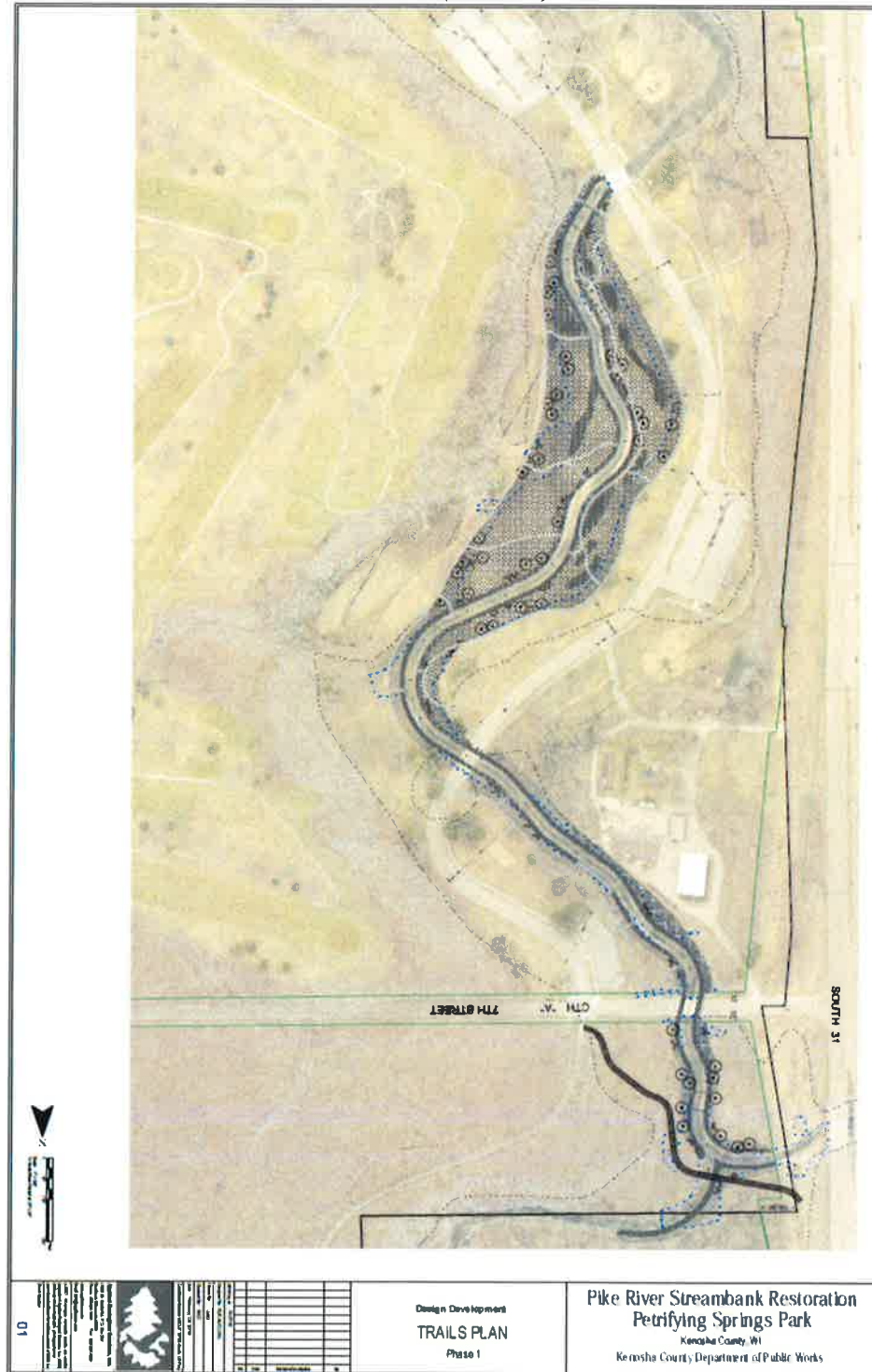

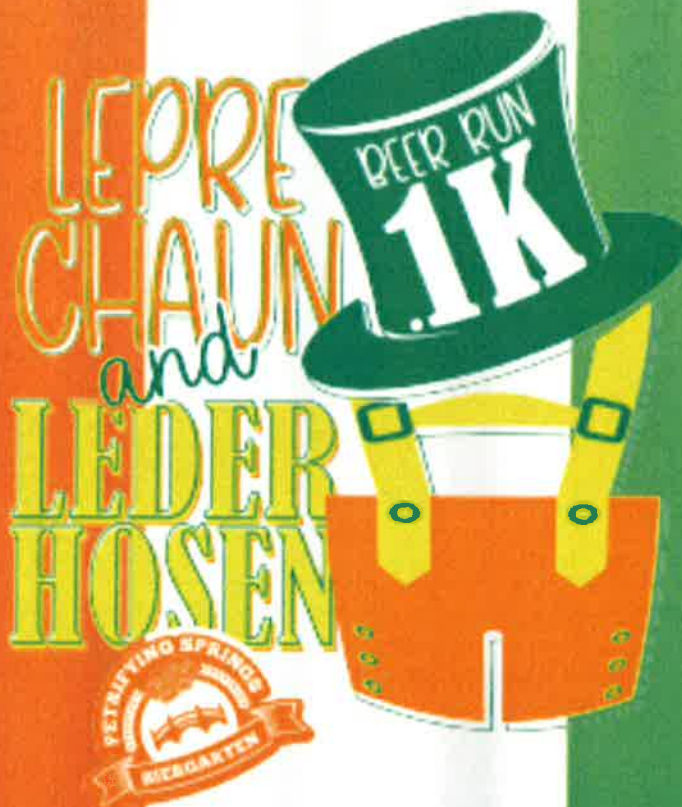
